

FOLD-SHIELD

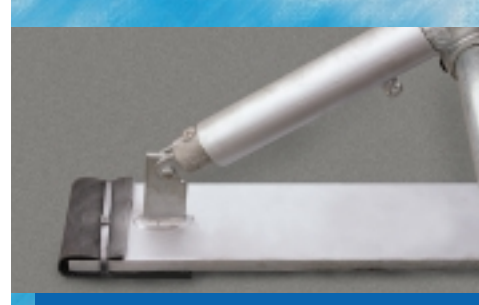
Collapsible free-standing guard-rail system. To be read in conjunction with the EDGE-SHIELD leaflet.

The installation of a free standing guard rail is an economic means of preventing falls from edges or openings. *Fold-Shield* has the added benefit of allowing the guard rail to be folded down out of sight when not in use.

Many architects will applaud this feature as it does not spoil the lines of the building, unlike permanently fixed systems.



A simple one way hinge can be reached by unscrewing the locking bolt, lifting the sleeve and folding the guard rail down. This enables the guard rail to be folded in towards the roof, but at the same time prevents it from folding outwards.
